

Major infrastructure proposal assessment

3-step process

December 2021

The diagram below outlines the process IWA will take for assessing major infrastructure proposals. For further information please refer to the <u>Major Infrastructure Proposals</u>

Assessment: Interim Guidelines.

STEP 1

Preparation of early stage proposal

Proponent prepares early stage proposal using the ACA or IA Stage 1 template

Submit early stage proposal to IWA

Review of proposals

IWA assesses all early stage proposals received

Feedback and annual advice

IWA provides feedback to proponents on all early stage proposals received

IWA prepares annual advice to the Premier. WA Government to decide if proposal proceeds to step 2

STEP 2

Proposal development

Proponent development proposal in accordance with SAMF and good practice

Engagement with IWA throughout development phase

Submit final draft proposal to IWA

Preliminary assessment

IWA undertake preliminary assessment, using consistent approach

Update proposal where appropriate

Preliminary assessment report provided to proponent

Proponent considers whether to update proposal prior to formal assessment

STEP 3

Formal assessment

Proponent submits proposal to IWA for formal assessment

IWA undertakes formal assessment, using consistent approach

IWA liaises with proponent and Department of Treasury

Report shared with Premier and proponent

IWA's assessment report and summary report is provided to the Premier

Both reports are also provided to proponent

Proponent attaches IWA assessment report to any subsequent ERC submission

Summary assessment report released

Summary assessment report is publicly released within 6 months of when it is provided to the Premier
